

The safety patrol's community service project will be benefitting The Labor of Love Animal Rescue, Cat Haven and Cat Crusaders. These animal rescues are both all-volunteer organizations working to rescue stray cats and dogs and find them forever homes. Their goal is to stop euthanasia as a population control. They also educate the public on the importance of spay/neuter and regular vet checkups for pets. Currently, they are in desperate need of cat food for the upcoming kitten season.

Beginning March 2nd, any student that brings in 10 cans or more of cat food for the animal rescue will earn a safety patrol mini-badge. Since most cans of food average about \$1, each \$1 will also count as a can. Your parents or guardians may also hold a cat food drive at their place of work. Turn in your pledge sheet with at least **24 cans** of cat food and you'll be entered for the daily news show prize drawing. Any student that brings in **200 cans** or more of cat food will automatically be able to attend the **WATER SLIDE PATROL CELEBRATION & COOKOUT** at the end of the year. The student who brings in the most cans of cat food will be awarded the **Humanitarian Trophy**. **All cans/\$'s will need to be brought in by <u>Thursday</u>, <u>March 12th</u>.
