Bus Safety Reminders

Always supervise your child(ren) at the bus stop.

Remember that our bus stops are often located in front of private properties. Show respect by staying off the lawn, out of the bushes and trees that belong to our neighbors.

Stay on the sidewalk while waiting for the bus. Our Wildcats have been reminded to sit or stand patiently while waiting for the bus.

Once our students get off of the bus, they are under your supervision. Plan to be at the bus stop to greet your child at the end of his/her school day. If you are unable to be there, communicate a clear plan with your child on how he/she should get home safely.

Car Rider Safety Procedure Reminders

School safety is our priority. Your patience and understanding is important at the beginning of the school year, as our procedures become routines.

Morning Car Riders

- ✓ Please drop off after 9:20 a.m. to ensure proper supervision.
- ✓ Please do not pass vehicles that are unloading while in the car rider line.
- ✓ Tardy bell rings at 9:40 a.m.
- ✓ Parents will need to sign a student in after the tardy bell.
- ✓ Our classroom instruction begins at 9:40 a.m. with the Wildcat News.

Afternoon Car Riders

- √ The bus loop is for busses and day care vans.
- ✓ Please use the car rider lane ONLY and remain in the vehicle.
- ✓ Dismissal will begin at 3:45 p.m.
- ✓ Parents must have a school car visor that is to be displayed in the front window or you will have to go to the office for a new one.
- ✓ Please do not pass vehicles that are loading while in the car rider line.
- ✓ Students may not cross the "Car Rider Line" to load in the parking lot unless accompanied by an adult.
- ✓ Please proceed slowly and listen for any instructions from school personnel.
- ✓ Students will be expected to meet the following car loop expectations.

Parent Pickup Line Procedures and information:

The Parent Pick up line will be located in the art room. Parents will be required to park at the high school parking lot and walk over on the sidewalk that connects our schools. Please be sure to have your tag with you at dismissal. If it is after 4:00 you will need to pick your student up in front office. In case of rainy days you may choose to still pick up in the art room or proceed to the car line. It is recommended that you do not park in our parking lot as this causes traffic flow problems and safety issues. Parents will not be allowed to walk up and pick up from the car rider line.

You may join your child for lunch on any day. Due to limited space for our students in the cafeteria, you may need to eat lunch in our courtyard at one of our picnic tables. Unfortunately, a rainy day may mean that we are unable to have you join your child as there is very limited alternative seating. In addition, our policy remains that you may only eat with your child at the designated tables. Finally, remember that our courtyard is not a space for recess, so running and/or ball throwing is not permitted.
